- This week we prayed specifically for help with our children's ministry and we've had four people sign up to help us in this area!

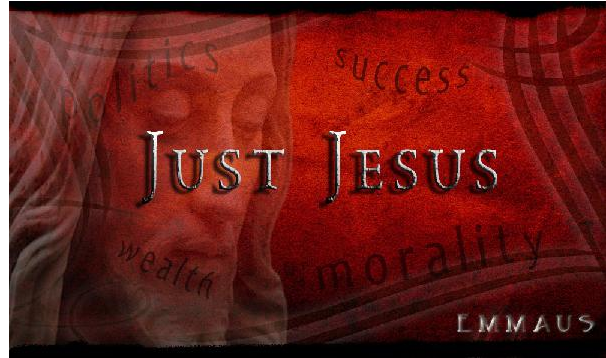
## Unplugged Services
