Education Statistics in El Salvador

Not only do rural students in El Salvador often walk long distances to school, they likely do it on an empty stomach (15% of Salvadorans live on less than \$1.25/day and a large portion in poverty). The conditions they study in are mindboggling but more so is the ability for students to do well despite the conditions. The schools around the Corinto church are bursting with optimistic students as more sponsored students than ever before have the opportunity to go to High School and even University. Thanks to you the sponsors, young people have a chance to hear the gospel and together with God make

a better El Salvador!

60% of children attend pre-primary education

93% of children attend primary education

55% of children attend secondary education

23% of students attend tertiary education—5% have a university degree
