

Greetings in the wonderful Name of our Savior and Lord Jesus Christ.

Titus 3:5 and 6 "He saved us, not because of righteous things we have done, but because of His mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior".

I'm very grateful to Jesus because He's faithful to me and to the church in Puebla, it has been difficult times for me especially, but great is His faithfulness. In the start of this year in the months of February, March and April, we were giving out many flyers in the area of the church, trying to reach out to the community with some Evangelic programs and films. We have some results from that, and we have some families coming from the area. We also encouraged the people from the church to invite their friends, family and neighbours to the special programs that we had in the church.

As the result of this work we open two meetings in houses on Thursday, one in the afternoon with an old lady who has 3 daughters and 2 sons. The old lady whose name is Ofelia and 2 of her daughters received Jesus as their Savior in the first day that we had a meeting in their house. These 3 ladies are diabetic the younger daughter is the more affected for that, she could not walk and her eyes are bad for the sugar in the blood, but when I teach them about the work that Jesus has done for us they opened their hearts to Jesus and I prayed for them and this lady now is able to walk. We had the opportunity to reach out to other members of her family, one boy and a girl, and a young woman who is her granddaughter, and since then I have the meeting in their house for over 5 months. We gave to them a Bible and a pair of eyeglasses that the older daughter could read to them the scriptures that I'm giving through the teaching of the Bible, and we are praying that Graciela and Mary that are the names of the daughters will be able to come to the church with other members of their family.

The other meeting in Thursday is in the evening, and is in the house of an old man 85 years old, who received Jesus in the church. He opened his house because he had a son who was sick for many years, and he did not know what do. We had the opportunity to lead this young man to the Lord and for a while he was getting better from his sickness. But three months ago he went home to be with the Lord Jesus. My brother and I just arrived in the moment that he was ready to go and we had the opportunity to pray for him and for the whole family, and nine of his family received the Lord as their Savior, and now some of them are attending church. His older daughter has problems with her eyes, before she was saved she was almost blind, but after that I prayed for her at their house, she started getting better with her vision, and now she is able to read the Bible and her two younger daughters received Jesus as their Savior lately. The old man whose name is Nabor, is very faithful coming to church every Sunday with some of his family, and he is full of the joy of the Lord and he has a very good disposition to help in everything that is needed in the church, he's a blessing to all of us and he's very thankful to the Lord. The Holy Spirit has been moving and one Sunday after the preaching about six people received the Holy Spirit speaking in tongues. Praise the Lord! It has been very encouraging for me to see what the Lord is doing in the people, I often think of Bob and I can imagine how happy he will be to see all that, and to see how the Lord is adding to His church how He had promised.

The Holy Spirit is moving in Puebla, in spite of all the violence that we have in the country, for all the organized crime and narco dealers, it's a very bad situation in all the Country, many people have died for this reason, and we are praying that the Lord will send a big move of His Holy Spirit and the all Christian Church here in Mexico will be able to reach out to more people in such way that we would be able to make the difference in this beautiful country, so far Puebla is one of the most secure states in Mexico, and we are very thankful to the Lord for His protection on us, we each week and each family at home every day are praying for the government that the Lord give to them the wisdom to control and eradicate this terrible situation that it's causing too many problems.

We are praying too that the Lord give us enough funds to finish the second floor of the church. We are trying to do that before the end of this year or in the first month of the new year, please continue praying for us in that aspect and for the Christmas program, that through these activities we win more people for the Glory and Honor of Jesus Christ, because we now that only Jesus can perform the changes that Mexico need.

I thank all ACOP Directors and regional mission Directors and special to you for all your prayers for me and the church, because we are working together for the Glory of Jesus Christ. I'm sending some

pictures I hope you will enjoy, and of course I will send some pictures from the Christmas program.

That the Lord Jesus Christ continue blessing you in the work that you do for Him.
