Things are always busy at the Village of Hope in Estonia, the program continues to grow with an average of 14-18 men. We project that this average could grow to as many as 20-24 men in 2008. The Lord continues to set free men and their families

from the bondage of drug and alcohol addiction. Our facilities are ever expanding with construction underway on our first staff housing and expansion of our mill, as well as other future plans developing. The Village of Hope in Estonia continues to be led by founder Mart Vahi and three other qualified staff

members who were once heroin addicts. They have now been raised up to be gifted ministers, leading groups, work crews, teaching and counselling the men that the Lord sends to us for help.

William, Roman and Kert came to the program almost five years ago. They have since graduated the program and have been faithfully serving in the ministry for several years now, having had much practical hands on training. William has worked very closely with Andrew over the past few years and has now been put in place as the Program Director under the guidance of Mart Vahi, taking over most of Andrews responsibilities.

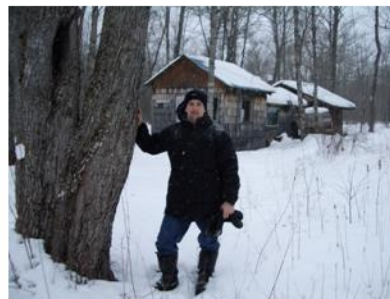


VILLAGE OF HOPE IN CANADA....
