



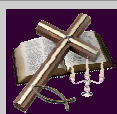

*Matthew 24:14* “And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.”



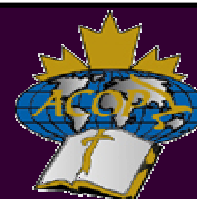
## ACOP MISSIONARY

Andrew & Erica Vahi



Andrew was born in Lahr, Germany and grew up as a pastors son in Fredericton NB. After rededicating his life to Christ at 19 years old he moved to Eston SK to attend Full Gospel Bible Institute for three years. During his third year he met and later married his wife Erica (Morrice) in her home-

town of Eston. Having a background in chemical addiction they both felt called to this area of ministry. They have received training from Bridges of America in Orlando as well as Dunklin Memorial Camp also in Florida. Both of which are long term in residence rehabilitation centres. Andrew and Erica moved to Estonia in 2002 as ACOP missionaries and have since then co-established the Village of Hope Ministry (a Christ Centered Drug and Alcohol Rehabilitation Centre) together with his father Märt Vähi. Andrew has taken on the role of program director, incorporating the concepts from these reputable programs. We believe the only approach to sobriety and freedom from substance abuse is through a personal relationship with Christ. Family recovery and Marriage classes are also taught, giving families an opportunity to receive healing in their own lives from the damaging lifestyle they have been exposed to from his addiction. We have experienced the Lords healing power through this ministry and the Graduates we send out are fine Christian examples taking the Gospel throughout Estonia.
